OPEN DAY DEDICATED TO THE LIFE INFUSION PROJECT CONCLUDES SUCCESSFULLY

Genova, 31st October 2024 - The Open Day "Technology and Innovation for a Circular Economy: Sustainable Solutions in Action in Europe," organized by AMIU Genova as part of the European project Life InFusion, concluded successfully.

The event welcomed representatives and stakeholders from across Europe to Genoa, gathered to discuss and showcase the progress made toward more sustainable waste and resource management. Funded by the European Union under the LIFE program, the project aims to develop practical and innovative solutions for wastewater management and to promote the circular economy.

The day was divided into two main sessions.
